...a quick study of God's edifying Word by R.J. Baker. Discover the truth and promises intended for every believer.

SENT BY THE FATHER

(Revised & Enhanced Previous Lesson)

Study Verses: John 14: 16; 1st John 4: 14; Matt 17; Mark 12: 32; Acts 1: 5, 2: 1-18

For many of us who believe that they have so matured in the faith to comprehend the fullness of God's plan of redemption, it would do us well to spend time reflecting on one line of scripture from 1st John. The Apostle declares... "the Father has sent the Son to be the Savior of the world". Patently clear to be certain, but also swift to the point. The old English preacher, C.H. Spurgeon, once again skillfully isolates and magnifies truths contained in John's statement. I am reminded with John it was all up close and very personal. As a disciple, loyal friend, obedient servant, witness to Lord Jesus' crucifixion, resurrection and ascension, the Apostle's knowledge and abiding faith made detailed explaining unnecessary. He lived the truth and he learned truth directly from the Master. Although there remains speculation that John, "The Elder" penned the two Epistles, there is little doubt they were recorded and celebrated from the Apostle's observations.

Spurgeon examines the phrase "the Father sent...and presses from it facts that some are evident, but others veiled. Scripture supports scripture! Space limitations preclude long description. This problem is lessened by study verses and corresponding resource material.

It is apparent that Spurgeon believes many Christians properly make the distinction between the Persons of the Holy Trinity, but inadvertently forget that there is no distinction in honor between Father, Son and Holy Ghost. This premise is confirmed by learning the perfectly coordinated function of the Trinity in Salvation. Jesus absolutely deserves our love, worship and devotion, but not apart from His Father who **sent, empowered and sacrificed** His beloved and only begotten Son. All of this was in accord with heavenly proclamations during the Lord's wilderness Baptism and the mountain Transfiguration. These events, preparing the Son for Calvary, were physical manifestations of **Jehovah's...Abba's...Father God's** perfect love, eminent approval and power bestowed upon the soon-to-be <u>Lamb of God</u>. Believers need remember the sole person to whom our Lord steadfastly prayed, offered up thanksgiving and cried out to in agony. We belong to Jesus; Jesus belongs to Father God.

The Holy Ghost, is supreme power unto salvation, acknowledging truth (Jesus), and our individual service. Peter was informed his declaration of the Lord's identity was enabled by the Holy Spirit. Several weeks following the ascension of Jesus Christ to glory, the promised "Comforter" arrived in Jerusalem during the Feast of Pentecost. There, taken over by an overwhelming spiritual force, the disciples become uniquely prepared to usher in the Church age. The "Third Person" of the Holy Trinity was shown to be absolutely essential in saving precious lost souls. Infinitely before creating the natural universe, the Holy Trinity was undivided in unity, presence and power. This side of eternity, distinction was provided for created angels and mankind to understand separation of persona and purpose. Although the Holy Spirit was "introduced" to the saints during Jesus' earthly ministry (generally speaking), a variation in honor was never intended. Contemplate...baptism by the Holy Spirit with fire, and rejection of the Holy Spirit as the <u>unpardonable sin</u>. The Spirit of God abides in us. Purposeful sin grieves and will drive Him from our "Temple", always to return in mercy upon sincere repentance. Until the Lord comes for His elect, The Holy Ghost remains God with us.

from the Nov. 12, 2024 Session Meeting







NOTES FROM OUR HIS KIDS TEACHERS!




